- (d) A " Fellow " means and includes a nerson approved by the Managing committee and whose contribution to the funds of the Sansthe amounts to a lumn sum of not less than B. 500/- ( Pive 'undred )
- (c) A "Patron " means and includes a persons approved by the Managing committee and whose contributions to the funds of the Sanst's amounts to a lump sum of not less than h. 1000/- (One Thousand)
- (f) A "Renefactor "means and includes a person approved by the Managing committee and whose contributions to the permanent funds of the Sanstha amounts to N: 5000/-(Pive thousand) and aboute.

## (b)-THE GENERAL RODY. ITS CONSTITUTION AND FUNCTIONS.

The General Body of the Sanstha shall consist of:-

- All trustees
- b- All members
- c- All life members
- d- All Patrons
- All Benefactors
- f- All fellows

A General meeting of the Body will be called every year during the month of May:

### FUNCIIONS

- IF To read the annual report and to get the sanction of the Body:
- II) The managing Committee will be elected every three years by the General Body.
- III) The quorum will be held at the attendance of atleast 1/10 th off the members of the body,
- IV) To elect a president and a managing committee
- V) To manction the activities done by the Managing Committee during last year.
- VI) To pass the budget put forth by the managing committee:
- VII) To appoint an internal auditer:
- viii) To superwise the work of the Sanstha:
- IX) The general Body shall consider and decade all matters referred to it by the managing committee;
- X) The president of the Sanstha shall preside over all meetings of the General Body. Whenever he is present, and in absence of the President the Vice President present shall preside. In the absence of President and Vice-president the members present shall elect a chairman for the transaction of the business of the meeting.
- XI) All questions before the General Body shall be decided, on show of hands by majority of votes. In case of equality of votes, the Chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote.

- n) To exercise such other powers as may from time to time be conferred on it by the General Body
- o) The Managing Committee shall meet atleast four times a year. Six members shall form a quorum. The president shall preside each meeting and in his absence members present shall elect a Chairman All questions before the committeewill be decided on show of hands by majority of votes and in the case of equality of votes the chairma of the meeting shall have a casting vote;

## THE BODY OF LIFEREMBERS

- 2-A Life-Member is one who accepts the aims and objects of the Sansthe and promises in writing to work in conection with the institutions of the Sanstha at any of its centres and who is so elected by the @ General Body.
